

Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 1 – Autumn 1

I can read and write numbers 1-10 in numerals and words.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

1 = one
2 = two
3 = three
4 = four
5 = five
6 = six
7 = seven
8 = eight
9 = nine
10 = ten

Key Vocabulary

Write eight in **numerals**?

How do you write 4 in **words**?

They should be able to recognise and write or spell these numbers in any order.

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Use practical resources – Your child has three potatoes on their plate. Can they write how many they have in numerals and in words?

Make a poster – Your child could make a poster showing the numbers up to 10.
