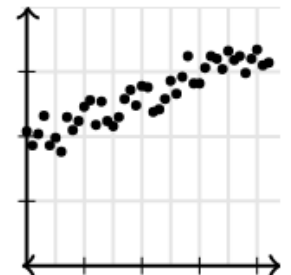
Must – know knowledge

By the end of the unit, children will:

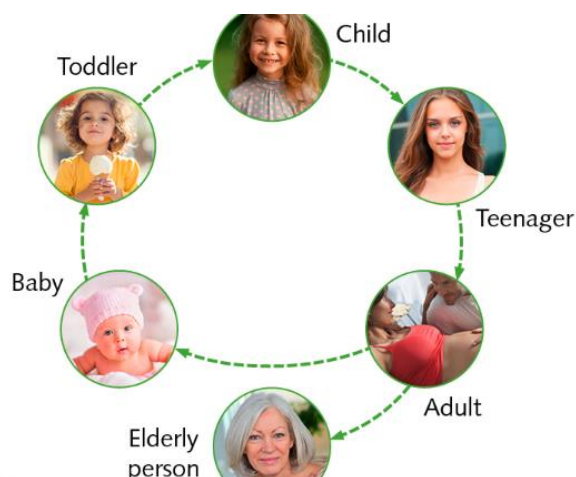
- Identify and name the external body parts of males and females, including private parts (penis, vagina).
- Understand that boys and girls have some body parts that are the same and some that are different.
- Recognise that private parts are private and that it's important to respect each other's bodies.
- Know the correct scientific names for private parts and use them appropriately.

Working Scientifically

- Use secondary sources to find out about the human body and differences between males and females.
- Ask and answer questions using appropriate scientific vocabulary.
- Record findings using drawings and labels.
