

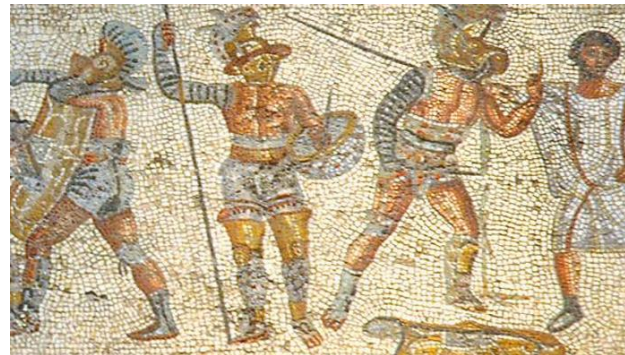
Prior knowledge: What they should
