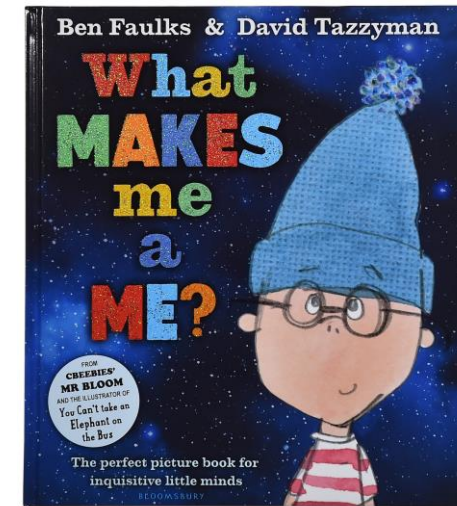

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We are learning to...

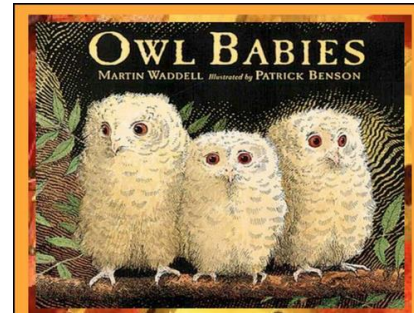
- Talk about how we are feeling
