

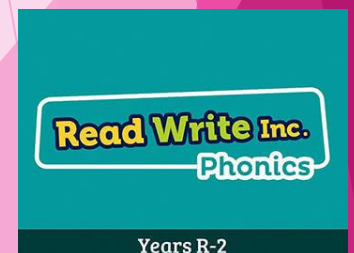
Spring 1 Nursery -People Who Help Us

Maths- Key Learning

- Develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subitising').
- Recite numbers past 5.
- Say one number for each item in order: 1,2,3,4,5.
- Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total ('cardinal principle').
- Show 'finger numbers' up to 5.
- Link numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral, up to 5.

English - Key Learning

- Recognising initial sounds m,a,s,d and t
- Naming objects that start with the sounds m,a,s,d and t.
- Listening to and retelling stories they have been read.
- Role Playing characters with new information learnt.

The children will be learning to:

- Label different people who help us
- Talk from personal experiences of times they seen or interacted with a person who helps them.
- Make different crafts linked to our topic.
- Listen and explain what has happened in a story linked to our topic.
