### Fractions:

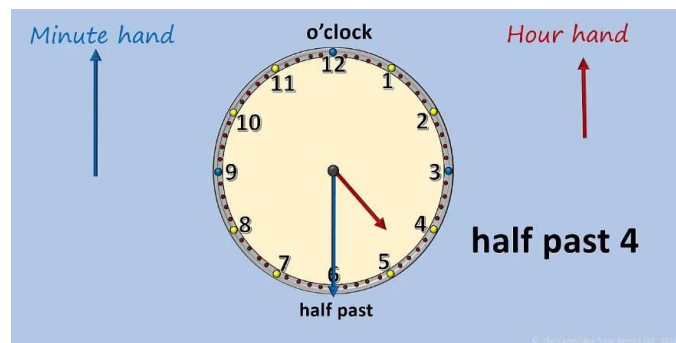
- To find a half of a shape.

- To tell the time using o'clock and half past.

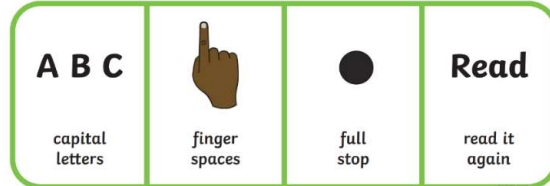


## English – Key Learning

- To use question marks and exclamation marks.



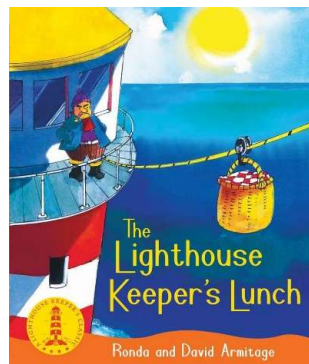
## Reading – Key Texts
