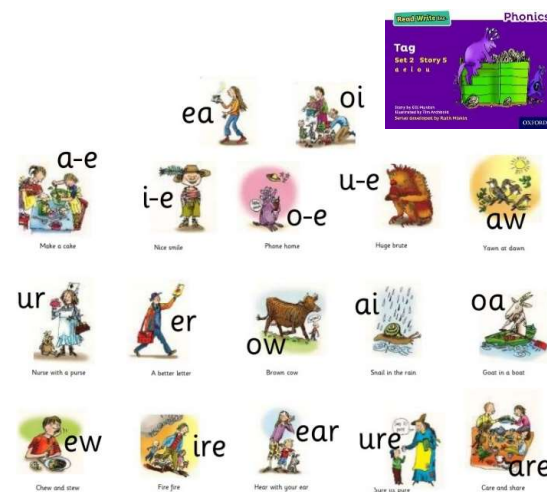
English – Key Learning
