Curriculum – Autumn 1

- Our topic this half term is the **Evolution of Toys**.
- Children are being encouraged to be inquisitive and ask lots of questions as they widen their subject knowledge.
- Science learning is based around identifying different **everyday materials**, their features and their uses.
- In RE Children are learning about **Harvest**.
- Our PSHE learning is focused on the value of responsibility.
- Our art topic is ‘Make your mark’.

Phonics and English

- Learning how to read and write is a crucial part of Year 1.
- In June 2025, the children will complete the Phonics Screening Check.
- Children are regrouped every 6 weeks based on phonics knowledge and reading abilities.
- Every morning starts with a 30 minute Phonics lesson followed by a 1 hour English lesson.
- We use a 'Talk for Writing' approach to encourage the children to write in imaginative ways.

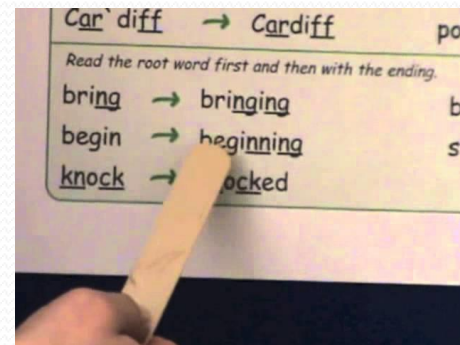

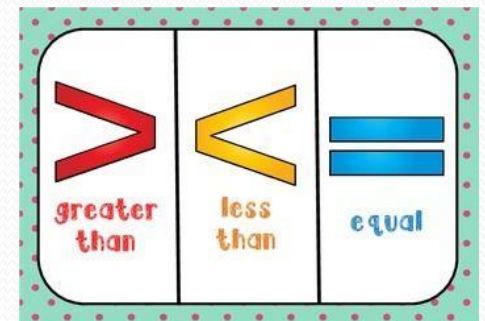
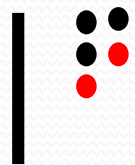

- The key strategy is to represent numbers using tens (lines) and ones (circles) for addition and take away.

- It is important for adults at home to support their child with their home learning. Answers will be discussed in class.

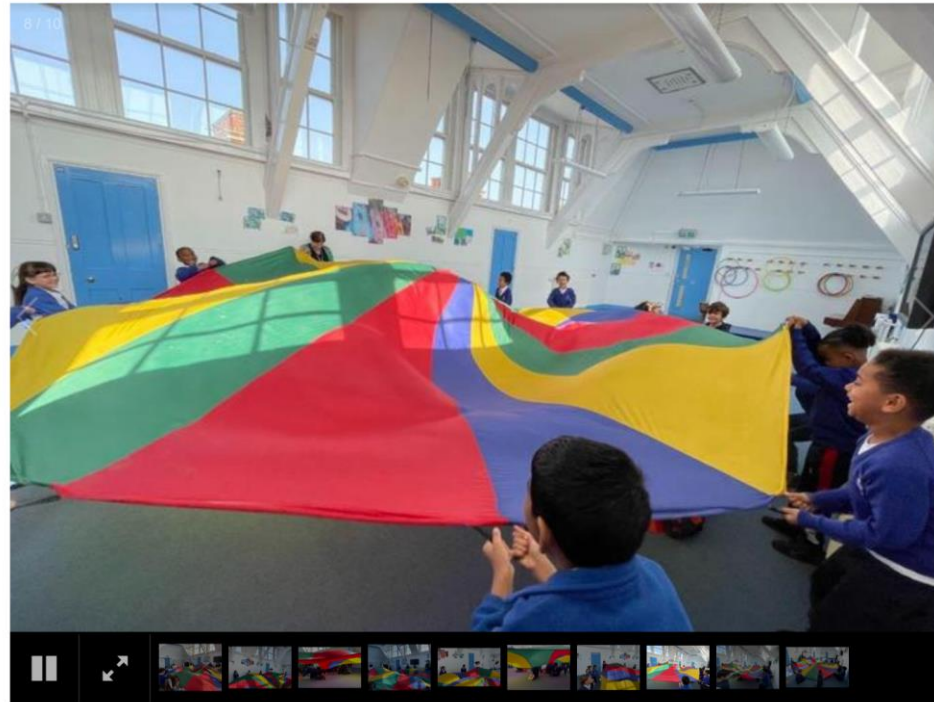
