- Knowing the minutes in an hour and the hours in a day

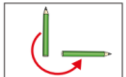
### Position and direction:

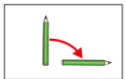

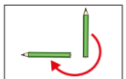
quarter turn

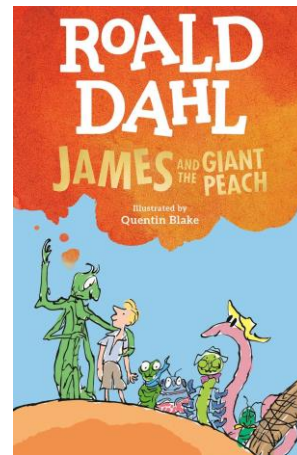

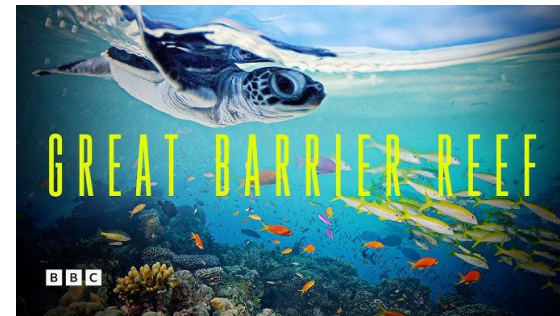
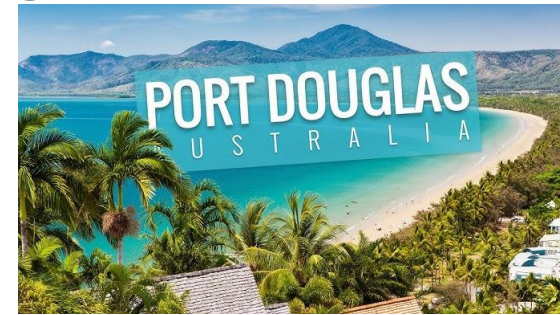
