Statistics:

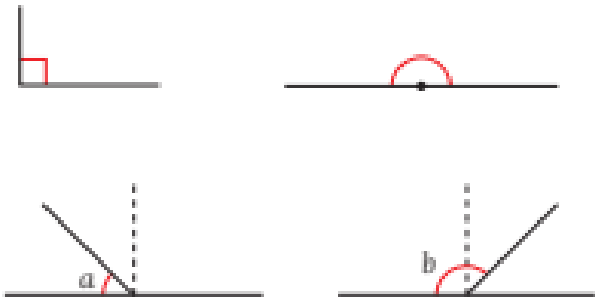
- Draw and interpret line graphs

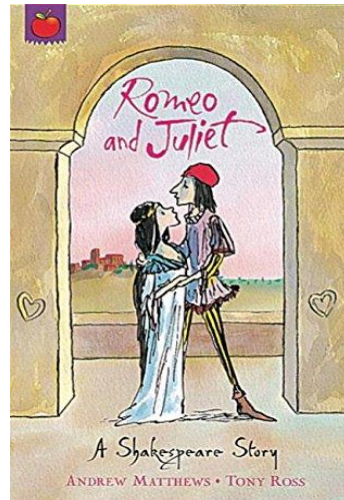
