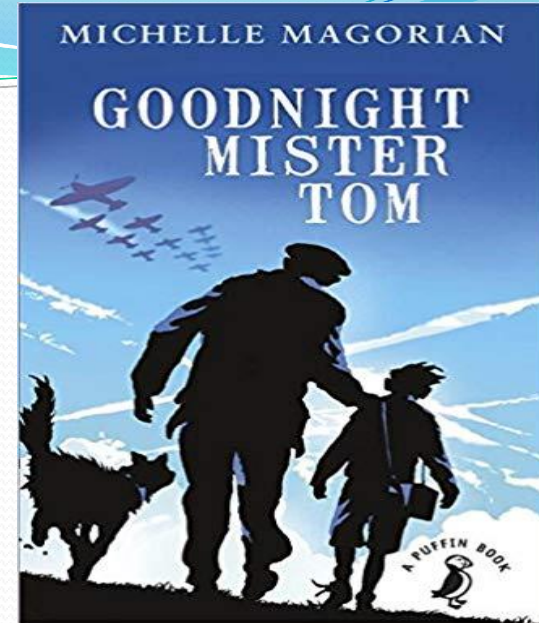
Curriculum



- English – Our topic this term is War (WW1 and WW2) We will cover a range of text types term including war poetry, newspaper report and a narrative based on the story ‘Goodnight Mr Tom’.
- Handwriting sessions will happen 2-3 times a week.
- SPaG lessons
- Daily spelling test– 5 words per day to be learnt for homework. Children will be tested on Fridays.

Curriculum

- Reading – Our focus text this term is Goodnight Mr Tom by Michelle Magorian
 - Students will continue to work on their VIPERS skills in Guided Reading sessions.
 - Students are expected to read their own book at home nightly and will be required to bring in their signed reading journal the following morning.

- Maths

- In maths we follow a learning timetable designed by White Rose, however learning will be personalised to meet the needs of the children.
- This half-term we have been learning place value and rounding. We have now move onto the 4 operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Lessons always include problem solving, reasoning and greater depth questions.
- Daily maths homework will help to consolidate the learning we are doing in class.
