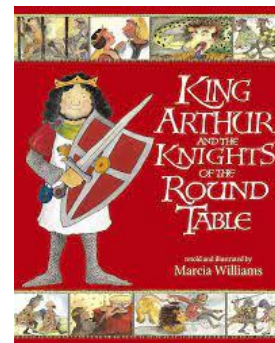
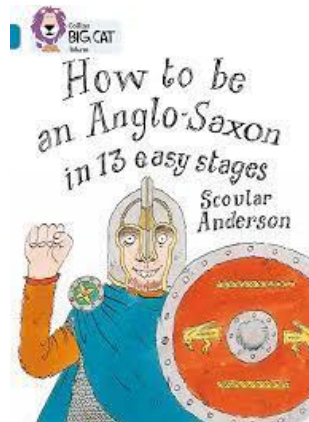

Foundation Subject Learning

PSHE – Perseverance

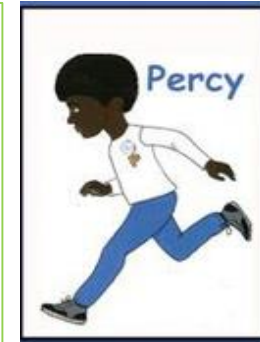
