

Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 1 – Summer 1

I can read and write numbers 1-20 in numerals and words.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

1 = one	11 = eleven
2 = two	12 = twelve
3 = three	13 = thirteen
4 = four	14 = fourteen
5 = five	15 = fifteen
6 = six	16 = sixteen
7 = seven	17 = seventeen
8 = eight	18 = eighteen
9 = nine	19 = nineteen
10 = ten	20 = twenty
