

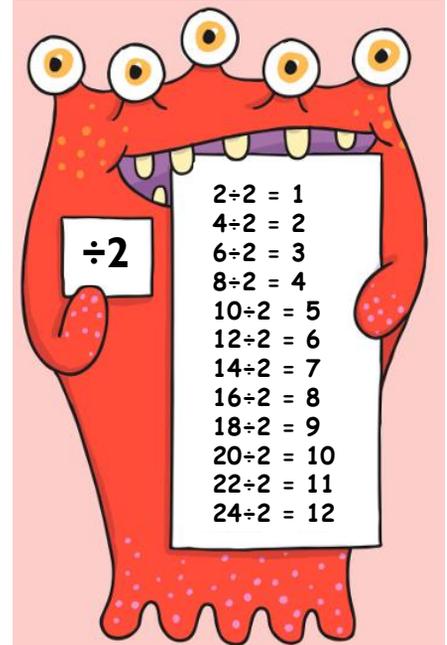
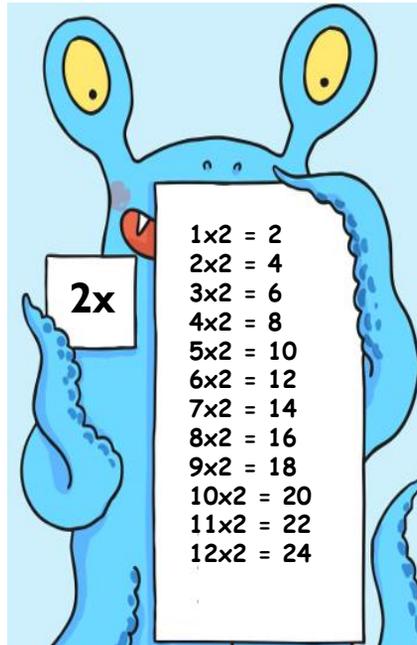
Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 2 - Autumn 2

I know the multiplication and division facts for the 2 times table.

Children should know the 2 times tables but should also know the reverse division facts.

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions.



For example:

$\underline{\quad} \times 2 = 10.$

Top Tips

1. Practise little and often. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey?

2. Songs and chants. Find multiplication songs and chants online. If your child creates their own song, this can make the times tables even more memorable.

3. Use what you already know. If your child knows that $2 \times 5 = 10$, they can use this fact to work out that $2 \times 6 = 12$.

4. Test the parent. Your child can make up their own tricky division questions and test an adult!

Question starters:

What is $_$ multiplied by 2?

What is 2 times $_$?

What is $_$ divided by 2?
